### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. **HOW ARE ASSESSMENTS BASED?** The assessment is levied on all citrus, except limes, produced within the State of California and marketed in fresh or processed form.
- **2. WHO IS OBLIGATED TO PAY?** The obligation to pay assessments is that of the producer. To facilitate collection, each processor or handler shall pay the assessment on behalf of the producer.
- 3. WHO MUST FILE REPORTS AND REMIT PAYMENT? Assessment report forms will be supplied by the Citrus Research Board. Each first handler or processor shall file a report and pay the assessment for the citrus producer. The processor or handler may deduct the assessment paid on behalf of a producer from any money owed by the processor/handler.
- **4.** WHAT IS THE MARKETING SEASON? The marketing season is the period commencing October 1 through the following September 30.
- **5. WHAT IS A CARTON?** A carton is defined by the program as a container equivalent to 40-pounds of marketed citrus in fresh or processed form.
- **DISTRICT PRODUCTION**: This is determined by the location of the fruit when harvested.
  - a. **District 1- Northern California:** Comprised of that part of California west of a line drawn due north and south through White Water and north of a line drawn due east and west through Gorman, but excluding San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara Counties.
  - b. **District 2- Southern California-Coastal:** Comprised of that part of California west of a line drawn due north and south through White Water and south of a line drawn due east and west through Gorman, but including San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara Counties.
  - c. **District 3- California Desert:** Comprised of that part of California east of a line drawn north and south through White Water.

#### 7. WHEN ARE REPORTS AND PAYMENTS DUE?

- a. Assessment reports shall be filed and payment made within fifteen (15) days following the end of the reporting period in which the citrus was received.
- b. Section 58930 of the California Food and Agriculture Code authorizes the adding of a ten percent (10%) charge for late payment, plus a penalty of five percent (5%) for each 30 days the unpaid balance of the assessment is unpaid.
